- 1. Teach a theology of congregational singing.
- 2. Pastors: lead by example.
- 3. Select songs with robust theology.
- 4. Select songs with profound poetry.
- 5. Select songs with stirring congregational melodies.

- 7. Arrange instrumentation not to overpower but to facilitate the congregation's voice.
- 8. Try to make the style of the musical accompaniment hospitable to the whole congregation.
- 9. Put songs in a key that fits the congregation's musical range and sing at a natural tempo.
- \*10. Encourage people to sing harmony parts.
- 11. Go a cappella often.
- 12. Lead singing invitingly.
- 13. Make the structure of each song intuitive to follow.
- 14. Turn the lights up.
- 15. Consider seating.
- 16. Introduce new songs intentionally.
- 17. Promote musical literacy.
- 18. Promote singing in the home.
- 19. Cultivate an encouraging and honest feedback process.
